NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The IRC Rules Parts 1, 2 and 3 and the PHRF rules of the Yacht Racing Association of Long Island Sound (YRALIS) will apply for boats in those classes.
- 1.3 For all boats, the YRALIS Minimum Equipment Regulations for Category C events will apply.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to boats racing under IRC or PHRF. In addition, "classics" with or without a rating certificate are eligible to enter.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by registering online and paying their entry fee at www.yachtscoring.com no later than May 10, 2010. Online entry is required; paper entries will not be accepted.
- 2.3 Late entries will be accepted until May 13, 2010 with a \$25 late fee.

3 FEES

The registration fee is \$85 which includes access to the regatta party on May 15 for 6 crew.

4 SCHEDULE

Dates of racing for all classes: Saturday, May 15, 2010

Number of races: one race

The scheduled time of the first warning signal is approximately 1100 each day. Racing will be conducted in a "Pursuit" format so that the slowest-rated boat will start first and the fastest-rated boat last. Starting times will be assigned by the Race Committee and will be shown on the scratch sheet, which will be available on Friday, May 14, at www.seawanhaka.org and at www.yachtscoring.com and posted on the official notice board at Seawanhaka.

6 MEASUREMENTS

Each boat shall produce a valid rating certificate. In the case of a "classic" that does not hold a rating certificate, please contact the Regatta Chair before May 8, 2010 to provide measurements.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be at www.seawanhaka.org and www.yachtscoring.com after May 1, 2010.

8 VENUE

The racing areas are Western Long Island Sound and Oyster Bay, NY.

9 THE COURSES

There will be two separate courses:

Classics Course: for the “classics” class, the starting and finishing lines will be the same: between the Seawanhaka flagpole and Oyster Bay Buoy 5 (Green).

Sound Course: for the IRC and PHRF classes, the starting and finishing areas will be in the proximity of Bell Buoy 32A (Red), south of Stamford, CT.

Each course is intended to be approximately 25 to 30 nautical miles but may be longer or shorter at the discretion of the Race Committee. The Race Committee will signal the marks of the course prior to the warning signal each day.

11 SCORING

The scoring system is as follows: each race will be scored using that Class’s rating system taking into account that boat’s given starting and actual finish time; the series for each class will be scored using the Low Point System of Appendix A. All Classes will be separately scored for the Alfred Roosevelt Trophy; in the event of a tie, the Trophy will be at the discretion of the Race Committee.

One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

12 BERTHING

Seawanhaka will offer a limited number of moorings at no charge for Friday, May 14 and Saturday, May 15 on a “first-come” basis; please contact the Regatta Chair.

13 RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

14 PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows: first, second and third place prizes will be awarded for each class and the Alfred Roosevelt Trophy will be awarded to the overall winner. Prizes will be awarded at Seawanhaka at the regatta party after the conclusion of racing on May 15.

15 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The Organizing Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
