NOTICE OF RACE & GOOD TIMES

1. RULES AND ADVERTISING

- 1.1 The races will be governed by rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* including Appendix D.
- 1.2 USCG approved personal floatation devices (PFD's) shall be available at all times while on the water by competitors. All competitors must supply their own PFD's. PFD's shall be worn outside of all clothing when worn.
- 1.3 Advertising will be restricted to ISAF Category A.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 Eligible competitors for PHRF racing shall be mono-hull boats belonging to or chartered to members of the Seawanhaka Corinthian Yacht Club, and skippered by members of the Seawanhaka Corinthian Yacht Club. If a boat does not have a PHRF number, one will be assigned by the Race Committee Chairman for the regatta at the Captain's Meeting. The race will be held in a "Pursuit" format where all boats will receive a starting time that will be for their boat and any other boat with the same PHRF. The theory is that everyone should finish at once.
- 2.2 Eligible competitors for one design racing shall be one design boats belonging to or chartered to members of the Seawanhaka Corinthian Yacht Club and skippered by a member.
