NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1 The races will be governed by rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* including Appendix D.
- 1.2 USCG approved PFDs shall be worn at all times while on the water by competitors, other than for brief periods while adding or removing clothing. All competitors must supply their own PFDs. PFDs shall be worn outside of all clothing.
- 1.3 Rules of the Sonar Class will not apply.
- 1.4 If there is a conflict between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions will take precedence.
- 1.5 The regatta is classified as a Category A event in accordance with Appendix 1, Regulation 20 – ISAF Advertising Code.

2. BOATS

- 2.1 Sonar type boats will be provided by the Organizing Authority.
- 2.2 The Organizing Authority will provide the following sails for each boat: mainsail, jib, and spinnaker.
- 2.3 Standing rigging shall not be adjusted, except by direction of the organizing authority. Backstays can be adjusted at any time.

3. ELIGIBILITY

- 3.1 Each competing team shall consist of three skippers and crews with three or four crew per boat. The total crew weight for each boat shall not exceed 700 pounds
- 3.2 Any substitutions must be approved in writing by the Organizing Authority.

4. ENTRY DEADLINES, FEES AND DAMAGE DEPOSIT

The deadline for receipt of entries is September 15, 2010. The entry fee is \$1,400.00 per Team plus a refundable damage deposit of \$1,500.00 per Team.

Racing will take place in Oyster Bay/ Cold Spring Harbor/West Harbor. Sailing instructions and course details will be provided at the Skipper's meeting.

8. **UMPIRING**

This regatta will be umpired.

9. **WAIVER & RELEASE**

Competitors at this regatta have been asked to sign a waiver and release of liability favoring the Organizing Authority, event sponsors, and the officials at the regatta.

10. **PRIZES**

The Lee Trophy shall be awarded to the winning team.

WAIVER OF LIABILITY RELEASE**

Circle one: SKIPPER CREW

As a participant in a Seawanhaka Corinthian Yacht Club Team Race event, I agree to the following:

1) **SKIPPER ONLY:** All skippers will be required to provide a \$500 damage deposit prior to the start of racing by providing credit card information at registration. The deposit is a per-incident maximum. If a skipper has more than one incident, he or she is then liable for up to \$500 for each subsequent incident. Skippers should be aware that while the Team Race Representative or Waterfront Staff will attempt to identify all damage at the post-regatta inspection, often this is not possible due to the nature of the damage. The skipper is responsible for all damage, even if it is discovered only after the post-regatta report is completed and signed. In the event that there is material damage not covered by insurance and no one acknowledges responsibility (e.g., crews are rotated among the boats and no one reports the damage), the cost of repairs will be charged to all the designated skippers on a pro rated basis.

As skipper of a boat, I am responsible for the following:

- a. Any contact incident resulting in damage to a Sonar.
- b. Inspecting the boat along with the designated Team Racing or Waterfront Staff both prior to racing and after racing. I will sign the regatta damage report that will identify all visible damage; however, as skipper I will also be responsible for all material damage even if it is not discovered until after the inspection.
- c. Delivering the boat to the location specified by the Team Racing or Waterfront staff and, if so requested, providing at least two persons to assist in hauling the boat and placing it on the trailer.

- 2) **ALL:** I verify that I can swim 20 yards and tread water for 3 minutes.
- 3) **ALL:** I will wear a U.S. Coast Guard-approved personal flotation device whenever I am on a boat unless actively changing clothes.
- 4) **ALL:** I acknowledge that sailing involves some risk and I understand that the decision to participate in this event is my sole responsibility and not that of the Seawanhaka Corinthian Yacht Club. I am acquainted with *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, Part 1, Fundamental Rule 4: A boat is solely responsible for deciding whether or not to start or to continue racing. In consideration of being permitted to participate in this event, on behalf of myself, my heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns, I hereby waive, release and discharge any and all claims, actions, causes of action and suits whatsoever, in law, admiralty or equity, against the Seawanhaka Corinthian Yacht Club and each of its officers, directors, employees, sponsors and agents (collectively as "Releasees") resulting from or arising out of my participation in this event or using the Seawanhaka Corinthian Yacht Club's boats or facilities.
